FUTURE-READY TECHNOLOGIES POWERING TRANSFORMATION



India stands at the forefront of a digital revolution, with companies across sectors embracing digital transformation at an unprecedented pace. Organisations across sectors are leveraging cutting-edge technologies to revolutionize their operations. Cloud computing, artificial intelligence, Internet of Things (IoT), and big data analytics are at the forefront, driving innovation and efficiency. This technological revolution has catalyzed an unprecedented demand for robust data center infrastructure and cloud services, with India's data center market projected to soar to \$10.9 billion by 2024, while the **Public Cloud Services market** is expected to reach \$24.2 billion by 2028, growing at remarkable CAGRs of 22% and 23.8% respectively.

This digital metamorphosis is supported by over 200 data centers across India, catering to the nation's expanding digital economy. The country's large consumer base, skilled workforce, and thriving startup ecosystem, combined with government incentives, make it an attractive destination for global data center operations. Long-term investment plans by hyperscale providers for self-built facilities further cement India's potential as a reliable global data hub.



Chennai has established itself as India's second-largest data center market with a colocation capacity of 88 MW and is expected to contribute approximately 25% of the new capacity over the next five years. According to latest industry estimates, Chennai's data centre capacity is projected to double by 2026, with ongoing projects set to add 2.6 million square feet (134 MW) by 2026 and an additional 2.5 million square feet (130 MW) planned for 2027–2028. These numbers represent impressive growth over the current operational data centre capacity of Chennai, which stood at 108 MW as of June 2024. With the growing demand for Al-enabled data centres projected to reach ~500 MW in India within four years, Chennai is strategically positioned to capitalize on this surge.

However, this rapid growth brings forth significant challenges. The sector grapples with critical issues such as data security, scalability to meet burgeoning demand, and a pressing shortage of skilled talent. Moreover, the advent of Al is reshaping the landscape, demanding new strategies for data management and processing. These challenges, if not addressed proactively, could impede India's journey to becoming a global leader in the data center and cloud computing space.

Building on the success of the Data Center and Cloud Infrastructure Conclave 2025 Bengaluru Chapter, Team Marksmen Network is now turning its attention to Chennai.
