# GLOBAL CAPABILITY CENTRES SUMMIT & AWARDS 2026 SPOTLIGHTED INDIA'S ASCENT AS THE COMMAND CENTRE OF THE INTELLIGENT ENTERPRISE

Global enterprises are undergoing a profound transformation. What were once cost-driven offshore support units have evolved into strategic engines of innovation, digital transformation, and enterprise decision-making. At the heart of this shift are Global Capability Centres (GCCs), now rapidly emerging as command hubs powering modern multinational operations.

➤ Against this backdrop, the **Global Capability Centres Summit & Awards 2026**, hosted by **Team Marksmen Network** on **11th March 2026** at **The Westin Mindspace Hyderabad**, convened industry leaders, policymakers, and enterprise decision-makers to examine the next phase of the GCC journey.

India continues to stand at the forefront of this evolution. Today, the country hosts over **1,600 GCCs employing nearly two million professionals**, with the ecosystem projected to grow into a USD 110 billion+ industry by the end of the decade. These centres are no longer defined by operational efficiency alone; they are increasingly leading global mandates across **artificial intelligence, product engineering, cybersecurity, enterprise platforms, and advanced analytics**.





Throughout the summit, speakers and industry leaders explored how GCCs are transitioning from operational support units into **strategic command centres shaping enterprise transformation worldwide.**

As GCCs assume increasingly strategic roles, conversations at the summit focused on the leadership imperatives that will define the next phase of growth. Leaders discussed how organizations must rethink **global talent development, AI-driven platform scaling, geopolitical risk management, and resilient digital operations** in order to unlock the full value of capability centres.

Anchored around the theme **“From Centres to Command: GCCs Powering the Intelligent Enterprise,”** the summit brought together **100+ senior leaders and industry stakeholders,** fostering meaningful dialogue on how capability centres are evolving into powerful hubs of innovation, leadership, and enterprise decision-making.

The **Global Capability Centres Summit & Awards 2026** reinforced the growing importance of India’s GCC ecosystem and its role in shaping the intelligent enterprises of tomorrow.

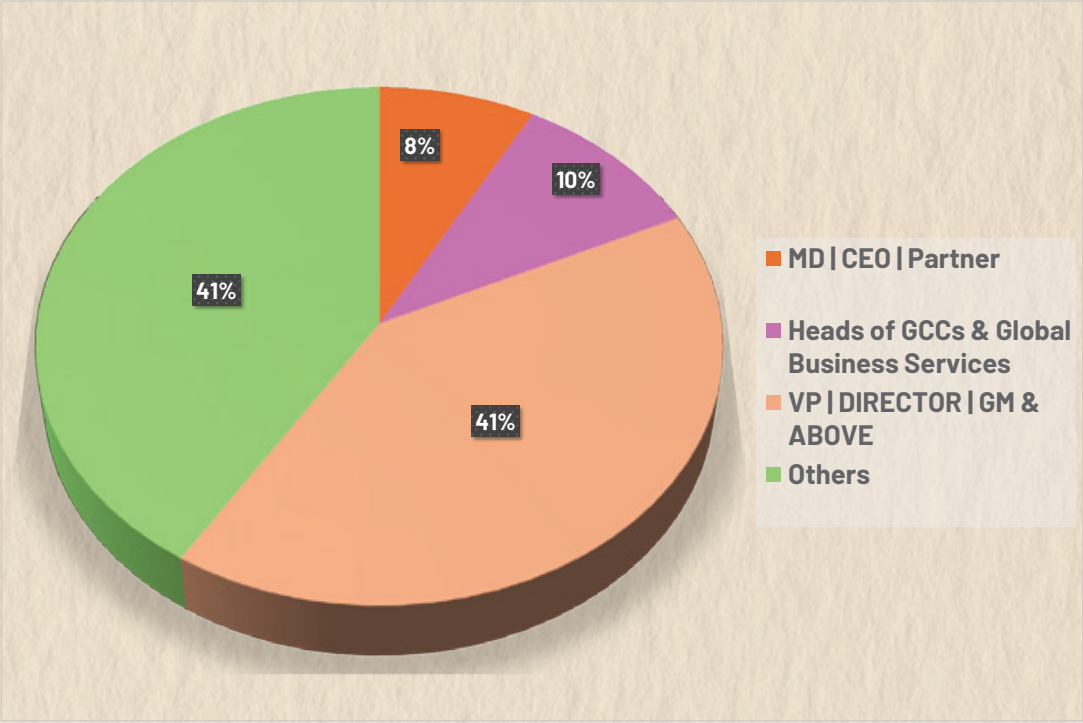

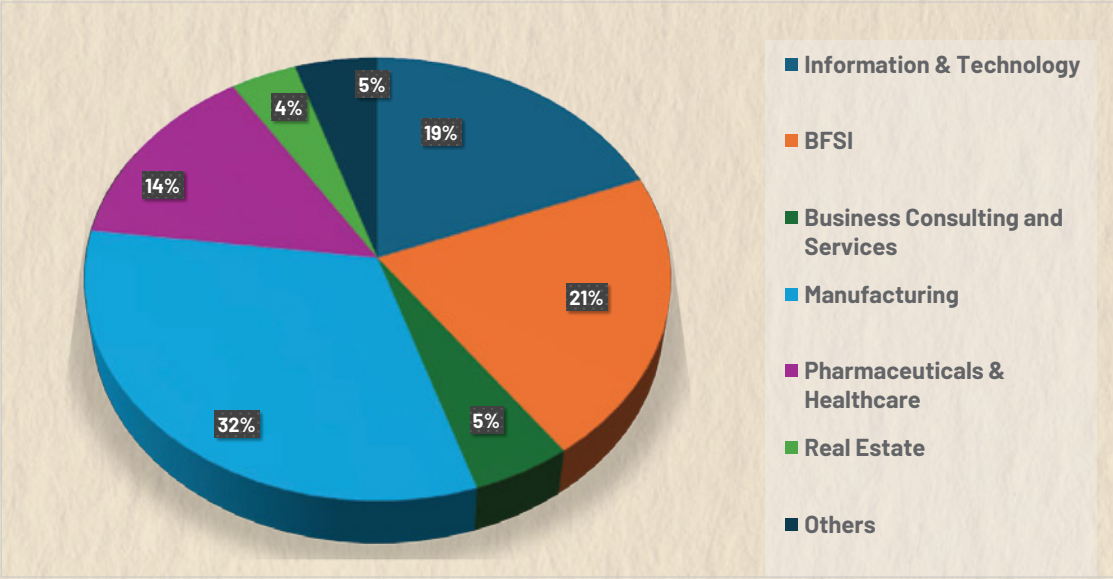
